

Montezuma Heritage Park Walkway Project

The Montezuma Historical Society and the Friends of the Montezuma Heritage Park have been hard at work making our park an exciting and relaxing place to visit. The recent addition of the Memorial Butterfly garden at the High Street park entrance has been the most recent improvement, thanks to donations from community members. The next step will be construction of a stone walkway, connecting the parking area, the kiosk, mural, Butterfly Pavillion, and the Byron Lapp trail. Bricks to start the project have been donated, and volunteers have begun the project, but many more will be needed.

To help fund and develop the walkway, we have begun a project where people can be honored in the form of engraved bricks which will be installed over the next year. Families and/or individuals can be honored for a tax deductible \$50 donation per brick. The 4X8 inch bricks may be inscribed with 3 lines, up to 14 characters per line and can honor living or deceased individuals.
